A clear presentation of the gospel is necessary in order that the weak and weary sinner might understand the grace and hope that the Gospel of Jesus Christ alone can bring. “How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of Whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher” (Romans 10:14)? And here is the gospel: “For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life” (John 3:16). The facts which must be believed are presented concisely by the Apostle Paul: “For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures” (1 Corinthians 15:3-4).
