“Strong Tower”, (Proverbs 18:10, NKJV)

“The name of the LORD is a strong tower; The righteous run to it and are safe.”

(Proverbs 18:10)

There is room enough in this tower for all who run to it. “The righteous run to it” and are not denied entrance. The entrance is always open to the righteous. “All our righteousnesses are like filthy rags” (Isaiah 64:6). So we do not come on our own merit. Rather, we come on Christ’s merit. “For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him” (2 Corinthians 5:21). There is no fear that anyone sincerely seeking divine fellowship will be turned away, for again the promise of the Lord still stands firm. “All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out” (John 6:37).
