"Therefore, having been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ" (Romans 5:1). Romans 8:1 and Romans 8:38-39 can also be applied here.

Everyone who thirsts, Come to the waters; And you who have no money, Come, buy and eat. Yes, come, buy wine and milk Without money and without price" (Isaiah 55:1).

Who is to come? Everyone who thirsts! "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink" (John 7:37). In the Gospel of John, Jesus calls Himself the Bread of Life and says, "He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst" (John 6:35).
